Town Green Tennis Club and its officials do not accept any liability for any personal injury, damage or loss, incurred by members or non-members using the Winifred Lane Tennis Courts.

All players participate at their own risk, and should take due regard and strictly observe the guidelines set out below.

Prior to play: -

Make sure your vehicle is locked and secure in the public car park

Clear court of any debris, wet leaves etc. Test surface for slippery patches both on court and at back of court.

Don't play on when it's raining.

When playing in hot weather – use appropriate sunscreen. Beware the effects of heatstroke – stop playing if you feel light-headed, weak, nauseous or start complaining of headaches or muscle cramps.

Respect the standard of the opponent at all times to ensure no dangerous play.

Use appropriate tennis footwear at all times.

Ensure the courts are always locked when leaving.

Ensure both lounge door and outer clubhouse door are locked when leaving

Last to leave ensures clubhouse locked and all electrical appliances turned off.

Ensure floodlights are switched off at mains when leaving clubhouse.

If at Club after dark make sure you have a torch.

Take care of step down when dark outside clubhouse door.

Don't leave the clubhouse alone after play after dark.

It is everyone's responsibility to report in to the Committee any perceived Health & Safety issues.

If you feel unwell, do not attend the courts or clubhouse, either as a player or spectator. If you test positive (Covid 19) you must self-isolate for the statutory period.

In a medical emergency a defibrillator device is positioned to the front of the Parish Council offices.
